CPSP-Philippines is an organization established to certify individuals for various levels of clinical pastoral care, and accreditation of Clinical Pastoral Education/Training (CPE/CPT) programs. ## Accreditation

We maintain standards for accreditation of Clinical Pastoral Education/Training centers. Presently, we have accredited centers in Baguio City, Manila, Iloilo, Romblon, Davao, and Capiz in the Philippines, as well as Ansan City, South Korea.
